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Focus of the evaluation

Internal Oversight Service

The extent to which parties have integrated the provisions of the 2005 Convention in their legislation, policies and strategies





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Key issues to be taken forward by Parties - 1

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1. **Sharing** of good practices among parties, intergovernmental organizations and civil society organizations
2. **Discussing** the impact of Articles 16 (Preferential Treatment for Developing Countries)
3. **Encouraging Parties:** to consider the implications of the 2005 Convention as regards cultural governance and to provide technical assistance focusing on this area





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Key issues to be taken forward by Parties - 2

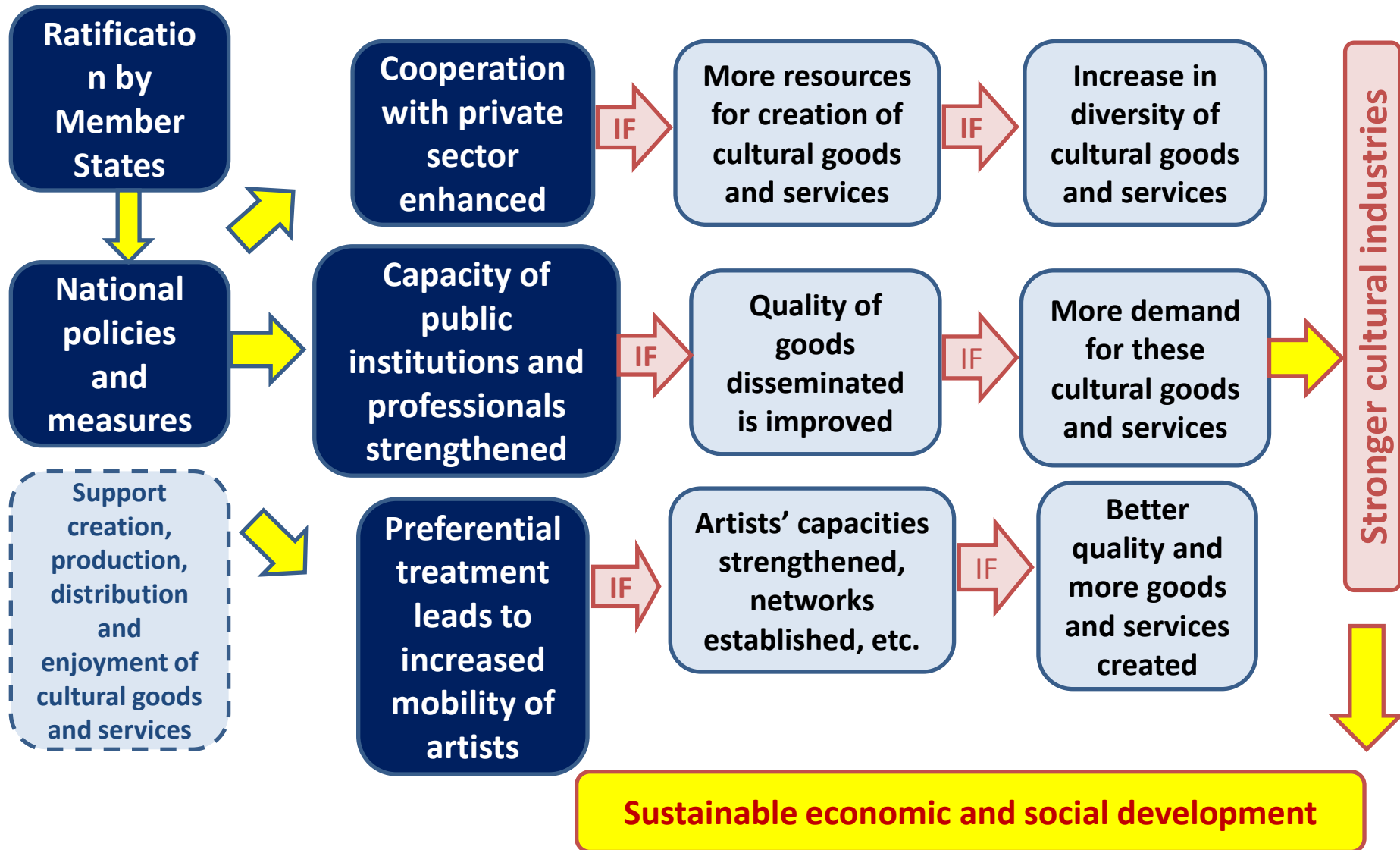
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4. **Paying particular attention** to the conditions (strengths/weaknesses) of cultural industries and the role of civil society actors in your countries, and considering the adoption of long-term strategies to address the identified needs
5. **Developing** an overall results framework for the Convention (including objectives, indicators and benchmarks)
