#### **1. OBJECTIVE**

##### **GENERAL OBJECTIVE**

To design and implement a training programme for teachers, administrators and other related educational actors; in order to promote significant learning that enriches students' life projects, through the incorporation of rights, interculturality and gender approaches, in the components of socio-emotional abilities, technical training and school retention, within the framework of the training strategy of the Horizons Programme.

##### **SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES**

- To prepare the formative proposal of the Programme for (1) teachers, (2) administrators and (3) trainers of CETPROS and IST for the incorporation of the approaches of rights, interculturality and gender, in the components of socio-emotional abilities, technical training and retention, considering the conceptual framework, the Horizons educational model, and the formative strategy of the Programme, as well as the training needs of all the actors involved in the programme, the work plans and the processes and achievements generated thanks to the development of the Programme in the last few years.
- To elaborate the designs of formative actions and materials for the development of the programme in the areas of the Horizons programme, considering the conceptual framework, the Horizons educational model and the formative strategy of the Programme.
- To elaborate the formative programme in the areas of the Horizons programme, considering the conceptual framework, the educational model Horizons, the formative strategy of the Programme and the work plans of each area.
- To provide technical assistance to the area teams of the Programme at regional level.
- Systematize the implementation of the experience of training teachers, administrators and other educational actors.

## 2. BACKGROUND

The UNESCO Lima Office and Auxilium Foundation have signed an agreement to implement the Horizons Programme - Rural Secondary Education in the Amazonas, Cusco, Ayacucho and Piura Regions.

The main objective of this Programme is to help adolescents and young people from the rural zones of Peru complete their basic secondary education with a life plan based on the integral and intercultural development of their abilities to strengthen their citizenship and improve their productive inclusion in their communities.

To achieve the main objective, the Programme develops three components, each with its own results and indicators: Quality and relevance, Retention of adolescents in secondary school, and Knowledge and impact.

The Horizons Programme is entering its third year of operation and requires the design and implementation of a training programme for teachers, administrators and other educational actors within the programme's sphere of influence. The purpose is to strengthen the capabilities according to the components and strategies of the Programme by presenting the Horizons approaches within the framework of human capabilities, specifying what value they add to the pedagogical process and to the significant learning linked to the life project. For this reason, it is necessary to contract the services of a specialized institution to elaborate and develop the training proposal, considering that the competencies and performances that should be promoted among teachers and administrators ought to be framed in the normative documents that the Ministry of Education proposes at the national level and the Programme proposal.
