United Nations Educational, Science and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) hereby invite qualified companies to submit sealed tenders as follows:

1. OBJECTIVE

To establish and strengthen an Observatory of Peruvian Education to serve as a reference point for the dissemination of research, educational policies and good teaching practices with emphasis on rural education, in order to generate a dialogue between citizens, students, teachers, researchers, media and politicians that contributes to the development of education in Peru.

2. METHODOLOGY

The Observatory's scope of action covers all Departments of Peru, with an emphasis on rural areas. Under the Horizons program, priority is given to the four intervention regions: Amazonas, Ayacucho, Cusco and Piura.

The Observatory emerges with the following axes:

1. Rural secondary education in Peru and its relationship with the concept of rurality and development.
2. The education of adolescents in Peru.
3. The role of the Sustainable Development Goals in the implementation of public policies in Peru and in the region.
4. Ethics and citizenship.

Advocacy actions will be also carried out with political actors and the public through events in the various regions, for the dissemination of the knowledge generated and the contribution to the establishment to an inter-participatory dialogue that gives voice to the various actors interested in the education sector.

3. BACKGROUND

The UNESCO Lima Office and Auxilium Foundation have signed an agreement to implement the Horizons Programme - Rural Secondary Education in the Amazonas, Cusco, Ayacucho and Piura Regions.

The main objective of this Programme is to help adolescents and young people from the rural zones of Peru complete their basic secondary education with a life plan based on the integral and intercultural development of their abilities to strengthen their citizenship and improve their productive inclusion in their communities.

The Horizons Programme is entering its third year of operation. It requires the design and implementation of an Observatory of Peruvian Education as a reference point for the dissemination of research, educational policies and good teaching practices with emphasis on rural education.

The purpose of this notice is to provide general information on the requirements for the procurement process and to inform interested suppliers how to obtain a copy of the Solicitation Documents.

Interested companies who wish to participate in the OIC must request for a complete set of Solicitation Documents, available free of charge, from UNESCO contact person at the address shown below.
