A certain number of countries requested to not open the debate and consider the draft resolution. 16. 2 Member States requested to vote on Roll-call on whether the Commission should open the debate concerning item 4.3 and related DR. 17. 66 Member States voted for the closing of the debate and 3 for the opening. 18.
