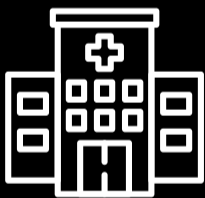

Display MIL-related educational posters/videos in hospitals, health centres and pharmacies



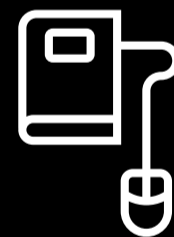
**Create and broadcast

Help citizens deal with misinformation and disinformation, through a combination of film screening, theatre plays and seminars



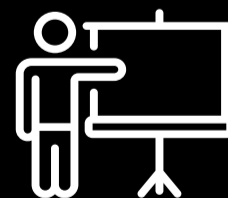
**Set up self-serving MIL
