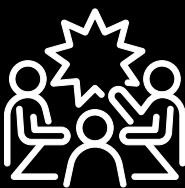

Choose themes that can help all levels of readers understand misinformation



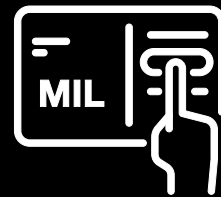
Team up with local media, medical, and/or science professionals
