- Subject line must say: 'Design Competition WPFD 2020'
- Your submission must be your own and must own the copyright of the graphic representation, design and concept.
- You can withdraw your entry to the Design Competition by sending a written notice to c.fitriana@unesco.org no later than Thursday, 30 April 2020.
