KRRiT as the regulatory body for audiovisual issues reports the following sources of verification of the "Internet Universality Indicators" in the scope of services within the scope of the Office's regulations:

- R (human rights) indicator: Theme B: Freedom of speech and Theme C Right to information on question C1 ("Is the right to information guaranteed in law and respectful in practice?")
- Sources of law: the Broadcasting Act and Executive Regulations of the National Broadcasting Council;
- Way of verifying in practice: Annual Reports of the National Broadcasting Council on the activity in a given calendar year along with Information on basic problems in radio and television for a given calendar year (reporting documents are submitted annually by the National Broadcasting Council to the Sejm, the Senate and the President of the Republic of Poland).
