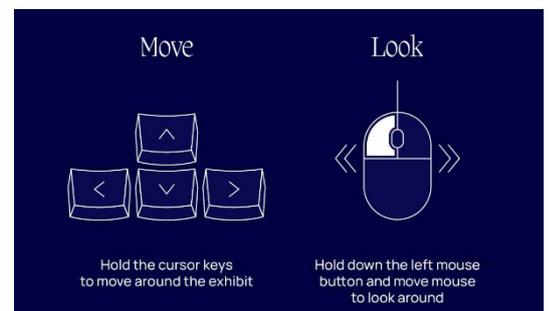
1. There are two galleries. Each gallery has different artists and artworks. To select either Gallery 1 or Gallery 2, click “[Enter the Walkthrough](#)”.
2. Click on the third option (in orange): “[Spectate](#)” or “[Observer](#)”.



You are automatically placed at the center of the virtual exhibition and you can start walking in any direction you choose.

3. **Walking:** Use the arrows on the keyboard to move. This will move you in a straight line to what is at the center of the screen. The left and right arrows will move you sideways in a straight line, and the up and down arrows will move you forward or backward in a straight line.

Alternative: you can use the keys W, A, S and D (QWERTY keyboard) or Z, Q, S and D (AZERTY keyboard) to move.



Like a ghost, you can move through walls: no need to go around them!

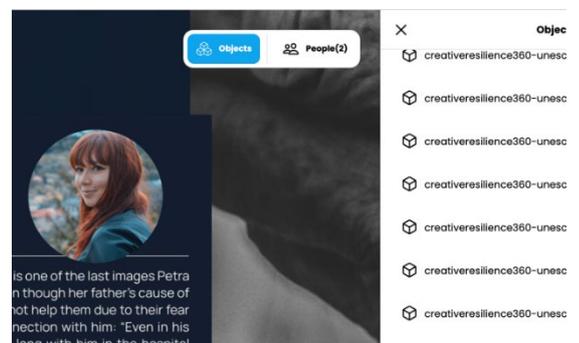
4. **Rotating (360°):** use the mouse (or hand icon) to rotate and move around the room by clicking and dragging one side of the screen towards the center.

Alternative: you can use the keys Q and E (QWERTY keyboard) or A and E (AZERTY keyboard) to rotate 360°.

Remember: *you are always moving towards the center of your screen. If you want to move towards a point, for example to the left, you need to rotate in this direction first.*

5. **Reading:** To view an image in full screen or reading text, click on [Objects](#) at the top right corner of the screen, select the image and click on [link](#) under the image.

6. **Locating an image:** click [Objects](#) at the top right corner of the screen, select the image and click on the [lightbulb icon](#) under the image. This will show you in which booth the image is located.



7. When you are done with Gallery 1 or 2 and would like to enter the other, you have to exit the current gallery by pressing Esc (or Echap) on your keyboard.
